From the Superintendent's Desk

The first semester progressing quickly with only three weeks left in this instructional period, and our students are continuing to grow and learn each day. I hope your Thanksgiving Holiday was rewarding and you took some quality and quantity time to relax and enjoy friends and family. The following are some days on the school calendar in December to make a special note of on your calendars for planning purposes. These days are the 19th, which is a 1:30 dismissal to end the second quarter/first semester. There will be no school on Friday the 20th as Christmas break begins on this day. School will resume for staff on January 3, 2025 with an all-region in-service day at ESU 7 in Columbus. The students will return on Monday, January 6, 2025 to begin their second semester coursework. I would like to take this opportunity to wish each of you and your families a relaxing, enjoyable and rewarding Christmas Season.

I would like to remind everyone of some very important winter information which we also shared in the November edition of the newsletter. When the **windchill factor** is 20 degrees Fahrenheit or below, the students will be allowed to enter the building upon arrival to school prior to the entry bell sounding and wait in an orderly manner for entry into the classrooms. The students who participate in the breakfast program, will eat breakfast and remain seated in the cafeteria until the entry into classrooms.

When we experience inclement weather severe enough to cause a late start or a school closure, we will make the announcement, first and foremost, through the district's PowerSchool Messenger Notification System. We will also utilize local news media. Inclement weather information is currently broadcast regularly by the following radio and television stations. 1. Radio: KLIR – FM 101.1; AM 900; FM 110.3; FM 93.5; AM 1510 (Columbus) 2. Television: KOLN –KGIN, channel 10 (Lincoln). Stay tuned to these information sources for winter weather information.

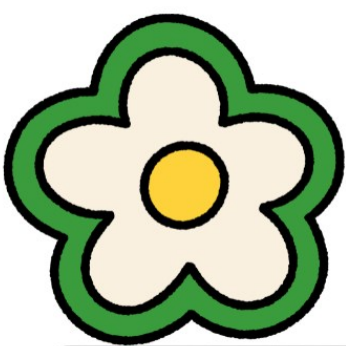

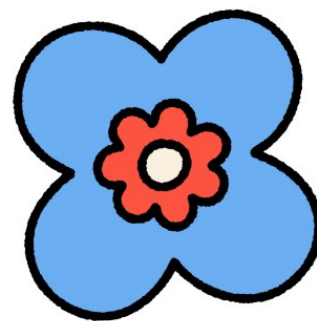

Student Council sponsored a pumpkin painting contest for staff, students, and school organizations.

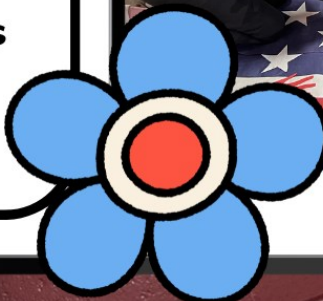
Details

Individuals or groups were free to design their pumpkin however they choose.

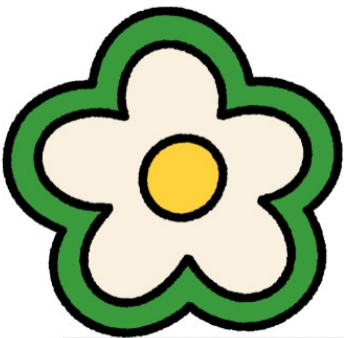


Student Council members helped assemble a flag made from PreK-12th grade students hand prints. The flag was displayed during the Veterans Program.



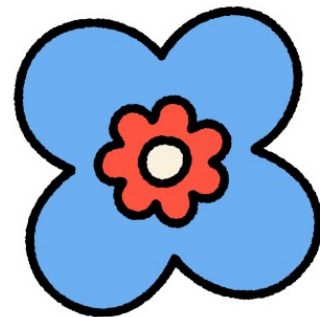
Results

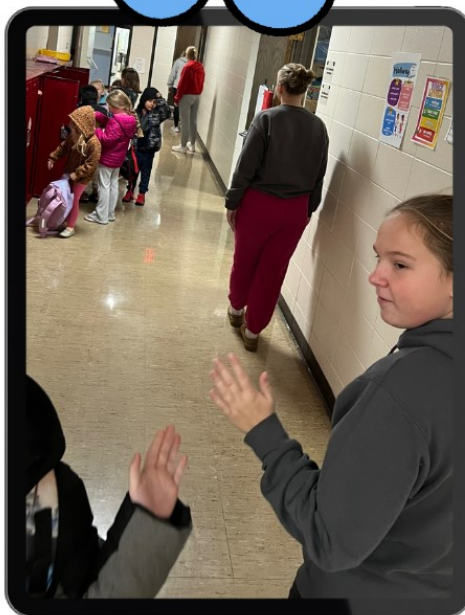
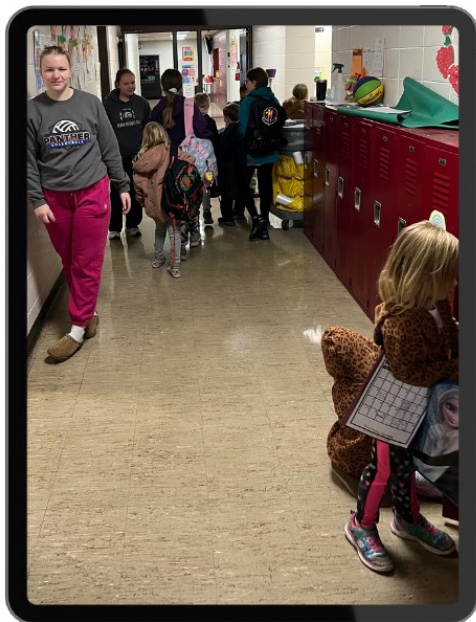

HOW IT WORKS

Nebraska students in grades K-12 have free access to online tutoring with a qualified Tutor in English, math, science, and social studies. Parents must first register their child. Once registered, students can request pre-scheduled appointments with a Tutor or log in and request on-demand tutoring to be connected with the next Tutor available in the queue. Students should provide homework for which they wish to receive help or topics that they would like to cover.

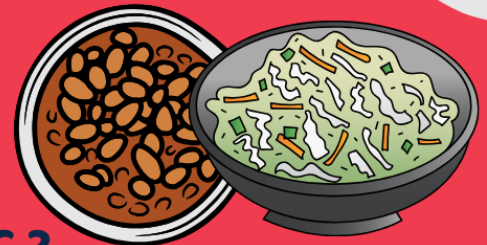

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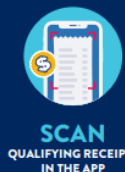
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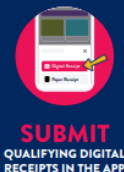

Blair noted that Mr. Arant told the students to never give up on your dreams.

On November 14th, 2024 Ms. Osantowski took Senior, Jace Jones to Kearney. They attended the Education Symposium, FCCLA hosted with Ed Rising, where members interested in pursuing a career in education can learn more about the process. Jace attended sessions that included: Competitive Events within FCCLA that could go towards his goal of becoming a teacher, Assistive Technology in the Classroom, and the History of CTE Education. The keynote speaker was Mr. Phillips, the 2024 Nebraska Teacher of the Year. Mr. Phillips talked about his experience and provided motivational words of what it means to be a teacher, he also shared some stories of who he has had the opportunity to teach.
