

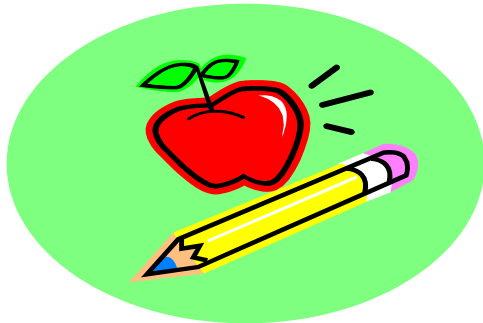

# Important Information

## Pick Up and Drop Off Time & Location

Drop off and pick up lanes will run from east to west on Clark Street & north to south on 7<sup>th</sup> Street.

### **Morning Session: 7:55-11:00 Monday-Thursday**

Parents will be allowed into the classroom on the first day of school for drop off from 7:45-8:00. **After the first day of school, drop off will be by the cafeteria doors and the students will sit at the preschool table in the cafeteria with the preschool para. The teacher will bring the students into the classroom at 7:55.**

Drop Off Time: 7:25-7:55. Breakfast is available at 7:25 if you would like to sign up. Please contact the school office if breakfast is something you are interested in. Please have your child dropped off by 7:55.

Pick Up Time: 11:00 Please have your child picked up by 11:00.

### **Afternoon Session: 12:00-3:20 Monday-Thursday**

Parents will be allowed into the classroom on the first day of school for drop off from 11:45-12:00. **After the first day of school, drop off will be by the picnic table in the white square by the drop off lane.**

**Drop Off Time: 12:00-12:05. Students should not be dropped off before 12:00 as there will be no one to supervise them. Please have your child dropped off by 12:05.**

Pick Up Time: 3:20 Please have your child picked up by 3:20.

## Late Start/Early Dismissal

- **If there is a late start, there will NO MORNING SESSION.**
- **If there is an early dismissal, there will be NO AFTERNOON SESSION.**

## Home Visits

Following the state mandates, 2 home visits will need to be completed for the school year. The first home visits will be held on August 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> if your child is starting school on August 19<sup>th</sup>. The purpose of home visits is for your child to meet the teacher before they start preschool. This is also a great time for parents to ask me any questions and share any concerns they have regarding their child. The second home visit will be fulfilled during parent teacher conferences if you are in attendance.

## Absences & Illness

If your child will not be attending school, please contact the school office to let us know. If your child is sick, please follow the school's Illness Policy. Students should be free of fever, vomit, diarrhea, pink or runny eyes, or any contagious disease for at least 24 hours before returning to school. If your child is absent with a contagious illness, please let the school know so that teachers and parents can monitor students for symptoms.
